#### **SOLID FOUNDATIONS**

#### **GILLIS ELEMENTARY**

This project includes construction of a new two-story classroom wing with sixteen (16) classrooms, restrooms, and provisions for vertical transportation. The Superintendent for this project is Keith (Bama) Ballard. He says the plumbing and CMU installation is complete for the first floor, and he has a major power outage scheduled to finish all underground electrical that should be complete by the end of July. The project is being managed by Kendall Bolton and still on schedule to be finished by July 2020.



#### **BAYOU RUM EVENT CENTER**

We have featured this project in previous newsletters, but it most definitely deserves a second look. Construction is now complete for this new warehouse and event center, which includes a catering kitchen, event space, barrel storage area, restrooms, and courtyard.
